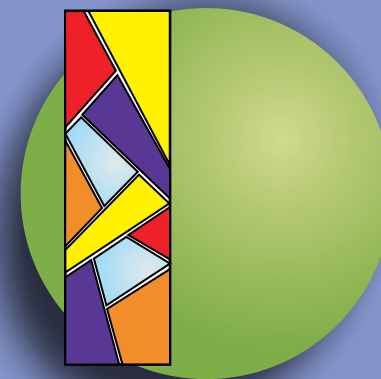

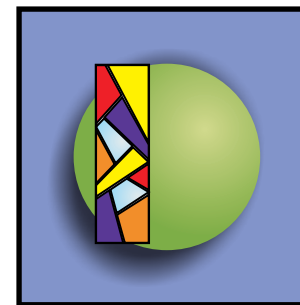

A variety of workshops, designed for both the beginner and the experienced glass artist, will be held in local artists' studios throughout the month of September.

Blow Your Own Glass

Every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday in September

Want to try out hot glass? We are offering a chance for you to blow your own paperweight, float, heart in our hot shop. We will walk you through the whole process from start to final sculpture.

Beveled Beach Treasures and Dragonflies

Bring some of your own treasures to fill the memory box that you will create during this workshop. You will also create a dragonfly suncatcher.
